

Camper Checklist!

Vaccinations

All Campers must have received Bordetella (Canine Cough) within the last six months, and be current on their Rabies and Distemper. Campers must also be spayed or neutered, and pass our free Interview Process.

Medications and Supplements

Camp Bow Wow can administer any medications other than injections. We can do pills, ointments, creams, etc. They should be clearly labeled in the original bottle with the pet's name and dosage information, and the reason for the medication. If you use a specialty food to administer medication, please provide it.

Food

While Camp Bow Wow keeps lams food on-hand for emergencies, we recommend bringing your dog's own food to prevent upsetting their digestive system. **A CHANGE IN THEIR FOOD WILL LEAD TO DIARHEA.** We suggest bringing their food in with a little extra in case you are delayed, in pre-measured baggies or containers.

Bedding and Toys

We recommend that you bring something that has a scent from home, such as a fleece blanket, dog bed, or towels. Feel free to bring toys for their personal use in their private cabins. Just make sure they are labeled if possible, and that we know how many toys they came in with.
